Help Every Voter Participate Equally

Don't assume the level of help a voter may need

When a voter is getting assistance...

- Do not influence how a person votes
- Direct questions to the voter, not others with them
- Help only as much as requested
- Two Election Judges of different major parties
 - Needed to mark a ballot according to voter's direction
 - Or do other assistance work related to voting
- Do not reveal the vote
- Do not challenge voter eligibility based on perceived cognitive capability

Curbside Voting

Curbside Voting:

The process of voting from a vehicle when a voter is unable to enter the polling place.

Curbside Voting

- Voter requests a ballot be brought to vehicle
- Usually requested by phone call or by curbside voter flagging down another voter to request assistance
- Two judges from different major political parties go out to assist the curbside voter
- Will likely see an uptick in utilization due to COVID-19
- Only Election Judges and Elections Officials can complete this process as part of "voter assistance"

Voter Assistance Laws

Changes for 2020 as a result of recent court decision

Anyone Selected by Voter (including candidate as result of court decision)

Voter can request assistance from others to complete voting processes in the polling place

- In all areas of the polling place, including voting booth
- As of 2020 court decision, there is no longer limits on the number of voters an assister can help with marking ballots
- As of 2020 court decision, a candidate may serve as ballot marking assistant

Except Employer Rep or Union Rep of Voter

Still prohibited from assisting voter

- State law still prohibits assistance from the employer or union rep of the voter
- Recent court decision did not change this


